

The COVID-19 pandemic affects proceedings pending before the Belgian State Courts and international commercial arbitration proceedings alike. Just as for courts proceedings, mandatory health and safety measures as well as travel restrictions make it strenuous to physically convene in a single location with all parties, counsel and arbitrators to hear the case.

On 9 April 2020, the ICC International Court of Arbitration issued a guidance note how to mitigate the adverse effects of these mandatory restrictions.
